When she retired from teaching, she moved to Mill Valley where she lived for 28 years, and began a volunteer career with "Senior Net", a non-profit group whose mission it was to bring computer technology into the lives of seniors. Always a teacher and a student, Fran traveled extensively to all of Western Europe and the Orient, often enrolling in studies abroad, most recently at Oxford. She especially enjoyed visiting her "adopted" family in Maggia, Switzerland and returned to Rome and Vatican City many times. Fran took an active role in her church, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church, Mill Valley, working in the Lector program, Renew Program, and producing the Parish directory. Fran leaves many adoring cousins and a local network of friends at the Redwoods in Mill Valley and surrounding areas. We will all miss her love, wit, energy and support.
